

Army To Sponsor Clinic

Army sports clinicians, 1st Lieutenant Thomas J. Acquaro and Sergeant 1st Class Peter Lufte, will conduct a soccer clinic on behalf of the Kings Mountain Army Recruiting Station Thursday at the Kings Mountain Senior High School, from 8:45 to 2 p.m.

1st Lieut. Acquaro, a company commander at the Fort Jackson, S.C. Basic Training Reception Station, has been playing soccer for more than ten years. After high school, where he played for four years, he played at Westfield State College in Massachusetts and also coached a local youth soccer league there. Since that time, in con-

junction with military assignments, Acquaro has played in the Honolulu International Soccer League and the Greater Indianapolis Soccer League. Presently, he is co-captain of the Fort Jackson Soccer Team and coaches for a youth soccer league there.

Sergeant 1st Class Peter Lufte, a senior personnel sergeant at Fort Jackson, has played soccer for more than 30 years. Starting in amateur soccer in his native Germany at the age of five, he eventually entered the German semi-pro ranks before coming to the United States and joining the Army in 1967. In 1973 and 1974, Lufte played for the University of New Mexico in Albuquerque was later active in intra-state soccer league competition in New Mexico and Alaska. More recently, he has been involved in a number of youth soccer programs in Columbia and he officiates for the South Carolina Soccer League. Sgt. Lufte has played on and coached championship soccer teams at Fort Jackson for the past seven years.

Both men will be in the physical education classes all day to teach, demonstrate, and coach the rules and fundamentals of soccer to all of the students. The faculty is being invited to participate.

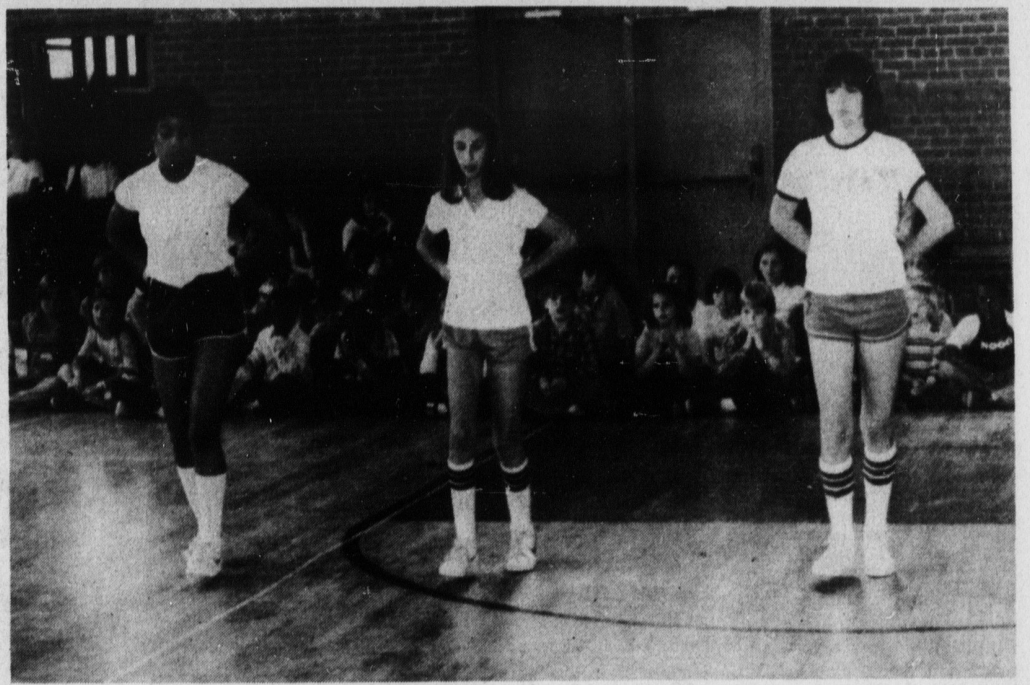

All necessary furnishing of material and labor for the installation and construction of fencing of the Deal Street Recreation Park Old Little League Baseball Field, Parker Street, of the City of Kings Mountain.
