

## KMHS Girls Qualify

Two Kings Mountain High girls tennis players qualified last week for the Western North Carolina Regional Tournament to be played this week at Hickory High School.

Karen Ledford and Pat Davis, Kings Mountain's number one doubles team, advanced to the semi-finals of last week's Sectional Tournament at Shelby to qualify as one of the four teams

from this section of the state.

The Kings Mountain team won three matches before losing to Lucy Spragins and Elizabeth Lutz of Shelby, who went on to finish second in the tourney. The final score was 5-7, 6-2, 7-6.

Ledford and Davis defeated Stamey and Stamey of East Rutherford, 6-0, 6-1; Queen and Edwards of Burns 6-0 and 6-0; and Harrison and Carpenter of

Bessemer City 6-2, 6-2.

The only other KMHS entry to make it past the first round was Caroline Harper. Laura Wright, competing in singles, and Wanda Witherspoon and Becky Bolt, in doubles, dropped their opening round matches.

The Mountaintettes finished fourth in the team standings behind Shelby, Ashbrook and Hunter Huss.

"We could have done better," said Coach Ed Guy, "but I think we did quite well considering our inexperience. With most of the girls coming back, I feel real good about our chances next season."

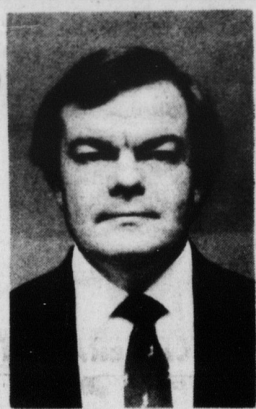
