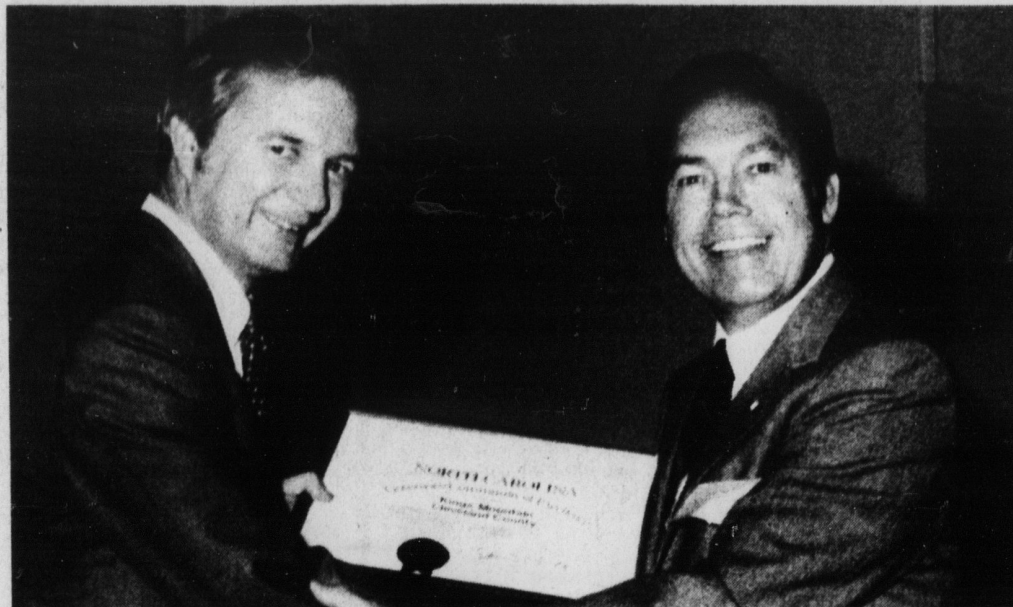
Gary Edge, V.D. consultant with the Eastern Division of the U.S. Public Health Service in Black Mountain, will speak of Venereal Diseases on November 17.

## Revival Scheduled

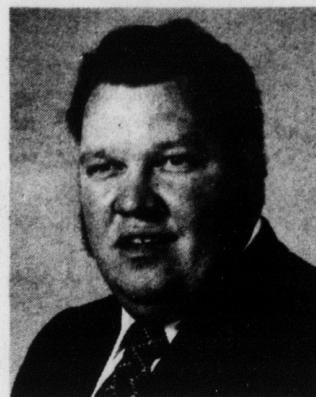
Revival services will begin at Macedonia Baptist Church, Grover Road, Kings Mountain, on Sunday night and will continue through Fri., Nov. 13.

REV. DAN WALLACE

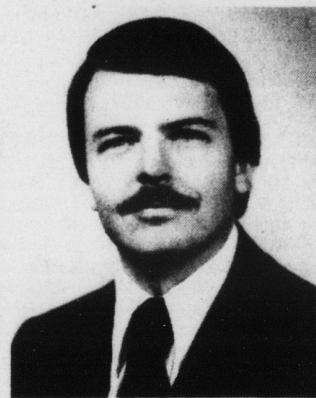
## Revival Services Scheduled

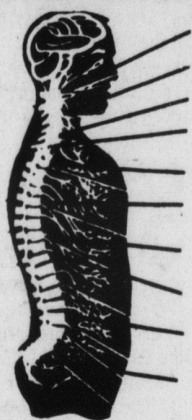
