Sealed Proposals will be received by the City of Kings Mountain, North Carolina, in the City Hall, in the City Clerks office, Kings Mountain, North Carolina, until 3:00 p.m. on November 27, 1981 at which time all bids will be publicly opened and all bid prices read aloud, for the following:

MATERIAL NECESSARY FOR ALL ELECTRICAL UNDERGROUND WORK FROM MOUNTAIN STREET UP NORTH CHEROKEE STREET ON HWY. 74.

No bid shall be considered or accepted by the City of Kings Mountain unless at the time of its filing, the same shall be accompanied by a deposit of cash or certified check on some bank or trust company insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation in an amount equal to not less than five percent (5%) of the proposal. In lieu of making a cash deposit, the bidder may file a bid bond executed by a corporate surety, licensed under the laws of North Carolina to execute such bonds, conditioned that the surety will, upon demand forthwith, make payment to the obligee upon said bond if the bidder fails to execute the Contract in accordance with the Bid Bond, and upon failure to forthwith make payment, the surety shall pay to the obligee an amount equal to double the amount of the bid bond. This deposit shall be retained if the successful bidder fails to execute the Contract within ten (10) days after the award or fails to give satisfactory surety as required herein.

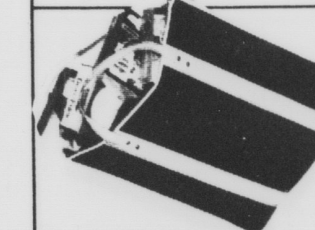
