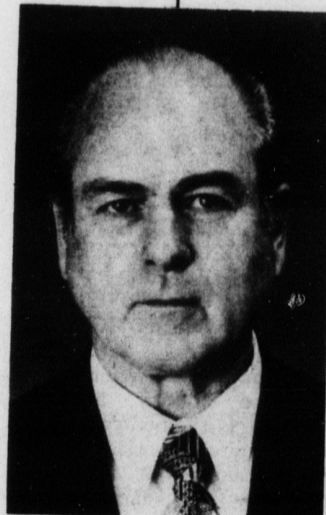
A prince among men
