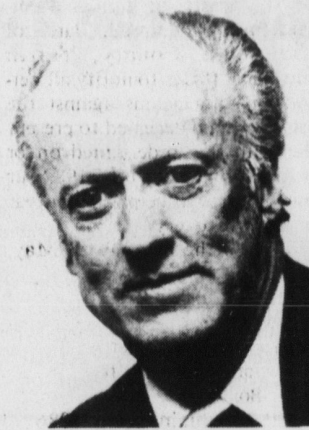
Smith, the founder of The Peoples Church, and well known to many.

Dr. Smith became Senior Pastor of The Peoples Church in 1959. Under his leadership the church has been forced to build six times, giving some evidence of the vitality of its local ministries. But in addition to its

strong local ministry, The Peoples Church has one of the strongest world missions programs in North America. Over 500 missionaries and Nationals are partially supported by the church, and its contributions to missions now total over \$1.5 million a year.

Dr. Smith has held evangelistic crusades throughout Canada, Great Britain, the U.S.A., Australia, New Zealand, the Orient, South Africa, India, Scandinavia, the West Indies and the Canal Zone, traveling in over 74 countries and colonies on five continents. In recent years Dr. Smith has been the main-speaker in over 140 world missions conferences. He is a dynamic preacher.

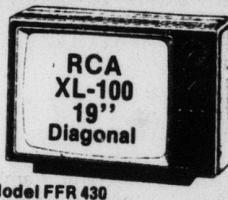
