## Denies Lincoln U. In Danger Of Losing Its Accreditation

OXFORD, Pa. (ANP) — Donald C. Yelton, acting president of Lincoln University, last week denied that the university is in

danger of losing accreditation. Denial also came from Dr. Alfred Farrell, director of public relations who called the report "pure speculation."

The university is periodically examined by the Middle States Accrediting Committee. Thorough examination is made of the university's buildings, financial records, alumni records, student records and other facilities. Annual accreditation is based on the committee's approval or disapproval. Yelton, who has held the

position of acting president since last July, stated: "Accreditation is normally on a fixed schedule. It is always theoretically in question. The fact is, that an accrediting

team is coming at its normal interval to satisfy themselves that certain questions raised at the last evaluation have been answered. There is, of course, the possibility that if they have not been answered that the team will find grounds for removal of accreditation.

Yelton added: "However, we don't expect it here. We expect that we will meet the standards, and that we will be in a position to answer their questions."

The chief administrator said that he has had two conferences with the head of the accrediting team within recent months. Indications, according to Yelton, are that the university will retain standing it has held since 1922.
