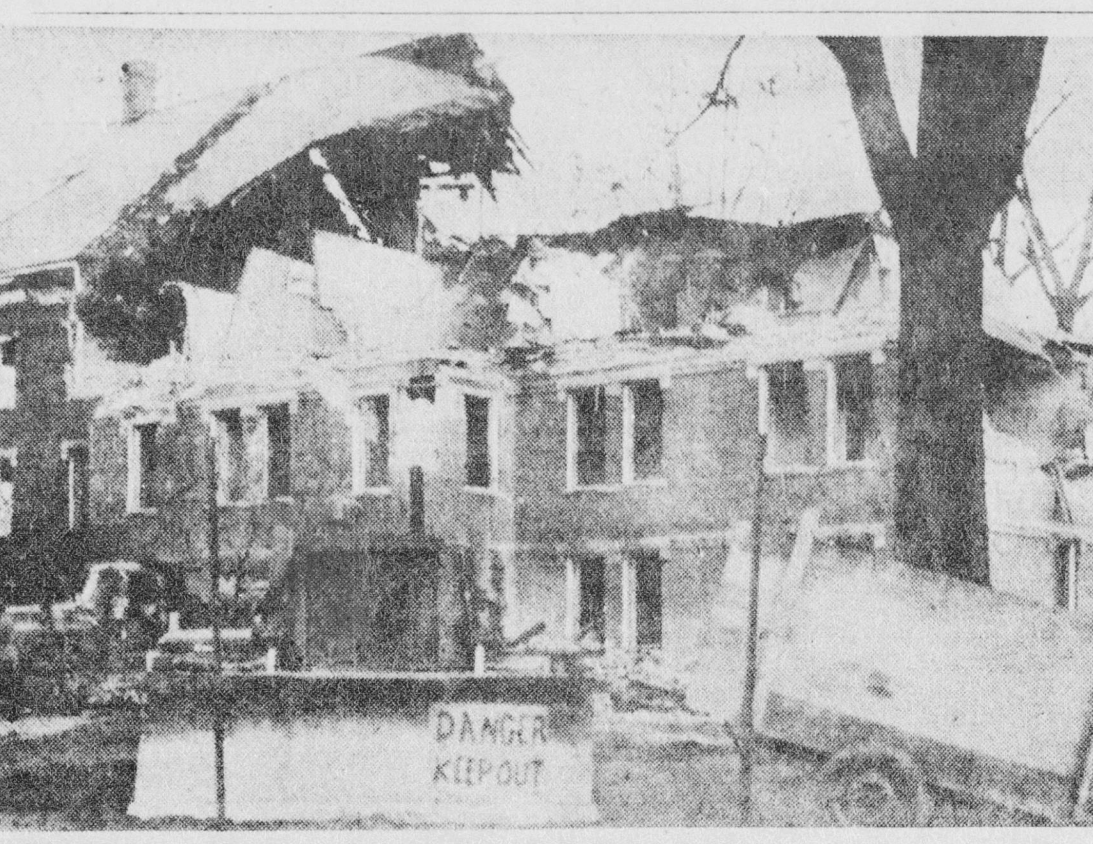

WASHINGTON (AP) — The row between the Teamsters union and the AFL-CIO flared anew here last week to almost wreck a "get acquainted" meeting called by Rep. Adam Clayton Powell, chairman of the Powerful House committee on Labor and Education.

Some AFL-CIO officials boycotted the meeting because a Teamsters Union official was present. Lobbyists for individual AFL-CIO unions attended.

AFL-CIO President George Meany ordered legislative representatives of the parent labor organization to stay away from the session after Powell invited Sidney Zagri.
