Dr. Player Among Seven On Ed. Trek

GREENSBORO — Dr. Willa B. Player, president of Bennett College, left New York Sunday for Africa as a member of a seven-woman team which will make a study of women's education there. The group, which will spend six weeks in East and West

Africa, will explore women's education opportunities with a view toward making it possible for more African women to further their education in America. Dr. Player is the only college president in the group which is composed of Methodist women. While in Africa, Dr. Player will also visit Bennett graduates in Ni-

geria and the parents of undergraduates who come from Ghana, Kenya and Liberia. It is expected that an exchange program, scholarships and, or grants-in-aid will be established as a means of making it easier for African women to enroll in American colleges. The educators are expected to return early in May.

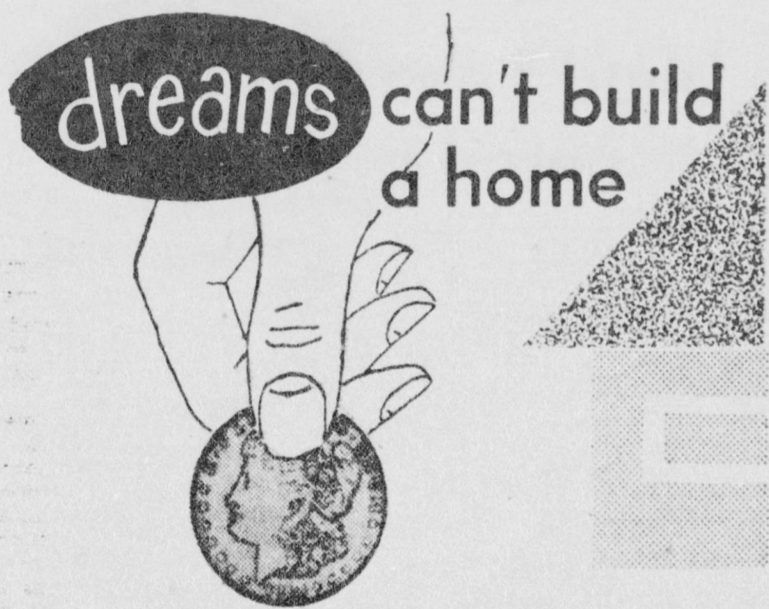

Yearbook Specialist To N. C. C.

DURHAM — David F. Ramberg, publications director for the American Yearbook Company of Hannibal, Mo., will be one of the chief consultants at the publications conference to be held at North Carolina College at Durham on April 7.

The announcement was made here by H. G. Dawson, Jr., executive secretary of Southeastern Scholastic Publications Association, sponsoring organization.

More than 200 students and teachers from high schools in the Carolinas and Virginia will attend the meeting at NCC.

Delegates will receive instruction from experts in advanced techniques of scholastic newspaper and yearbook publishing.

A major feature of the day-long publications confab will be the honor awards program in which newspapers and yearbooks will be cited for excellence demonstrated in such categories as news-writing, layout, creativity, pictures, picture-display and editorial writing.

Over fifty newspapers and yearbooks have been entered in the 1961 honor awards competition. Awards will be sponsored by publications related enterprises, such as daily and weekly newspapers and yearbook publishing houses.
