New Handling Method Saves Egg Breakage

The more times you handle an egg—from the hen to the carton—the more breakage you'll get. That's the opinion of Tom Morris, poultry specialist for the N. C. State College Agricultural Extension Service.

"We're in the horse-and-buggy days in egg-handling," says Morris. "The truly progressive poultryman has long since abandoned the bucket for collecting eggs. They don't even use rubber baskets—the big thing now is 'filler flats.'"

Morris cites the case of Maurice Pickler, Stanly County egg producer and one of the agricultural leaders of North Carolina. "Pickler cut out 50 per cent of his normal egg breakage by switching from round baskets to square baskets with filler flats," he says. "He figures he saved \$10 a day by the switch."

And a New York state producer cut his breakage by 85 per cent, Morris says. "Many poultrymen get a breakage often to 12 per cent," he points out. "It's easy to see what a savings can be made with a better method of handling eggs."
