Hundreds paraded at three Savannah schools. The boycott and parades were in protest to the firing of Alflorence Cheatham, principal of Sol Johnson hgih school. The walk-out started at Johnson and spread to Beach senior and Beach Junior highs. All are Negro schools.

Nearly 300 pickets marched a round the adjoining Beach schools chanting. "Freedom, freedom, we want Cheatham.

Cheatham, a Philadelphia native who holds a masters degree from Harvard University, was released without comment as principal of Johnson High School recently when the school board failed to renew his contract. He immediately resigned his \$8,30-a-year post. Neither Cheatham nor the school board would comment on the action, but W. S. Law, state president of the NAACP said Cheatham's contract was not renewed because




