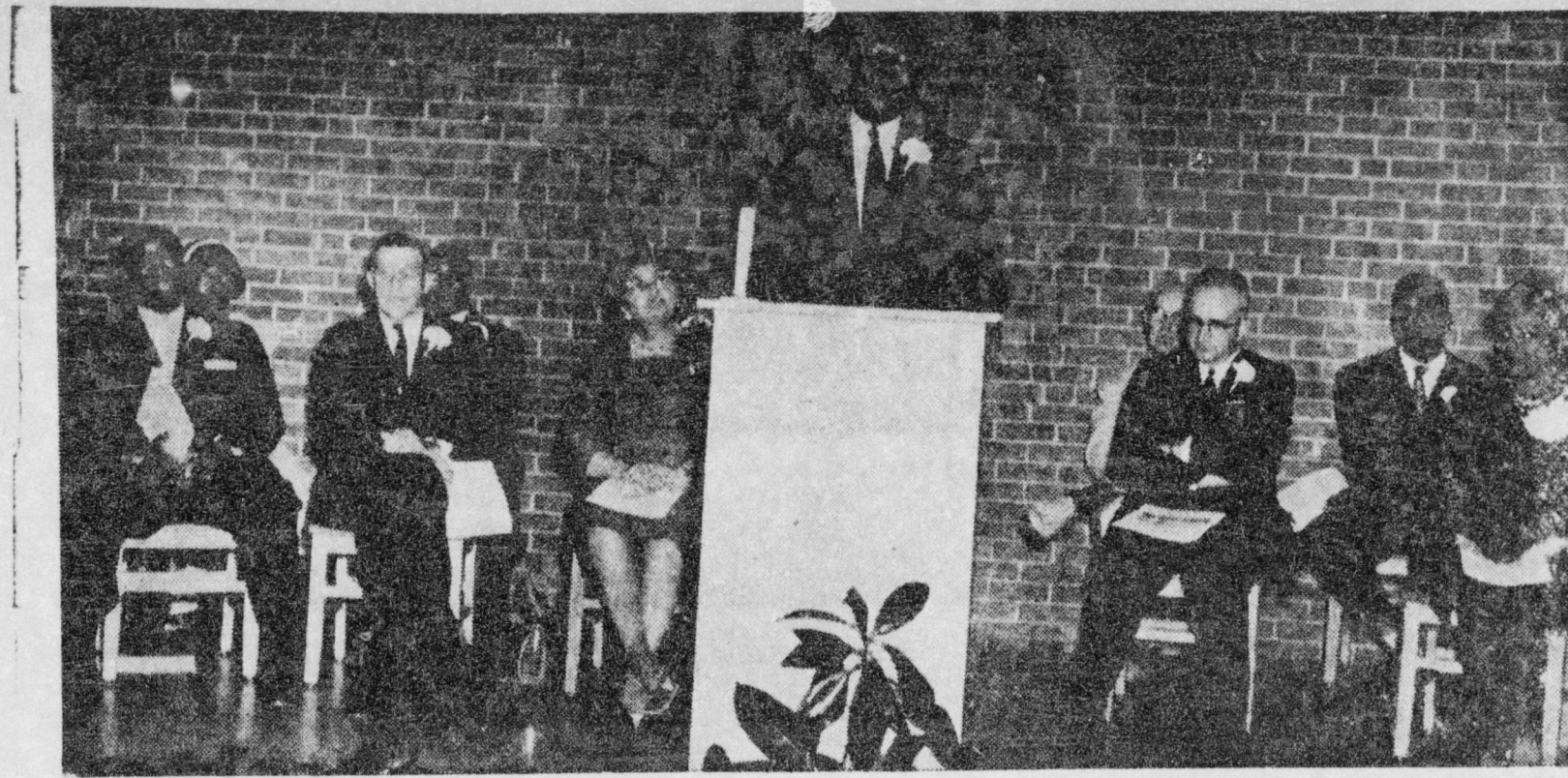
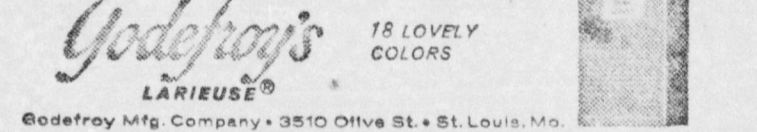

Robert Kennedy Declares Nation Is Hypocritical On Race Problem

WASHINGTON (ANP) — Atty. Gen. Robert Kennedy in a general denunciation of racial segregation lumped North and South together and declared the problem is national rather than sectional.

"I think there is a good deal of

hypocrisy," Kennedy told Bill Monroe, news director of New Orleans WDSU-TV, who interviewed Kennedy here April 21.

Talks on Many Topics
The interview, for broadcast from New Orleans dealt with school inte-

gration, voting rights, tidelands boundaries and other topics.

Monroe asked Kennedy about school integration in Washington, D. C., which Monroe said was "frequently used as a horrible example of what happens when schools desegregate."

Most of the white children have moved out.

Kennedy said he couldn't discuss the situation fully because he hadn't made a study. He felt a survey several years ago exaggerated the effects of integration. He said the situation was not perfect, but he felt it was a step forward.

It's Practiced Segregation
"And I'd say also that this proves what happened in Washington and even an examination of the school situation in New York or Chicago or many of our cities of the North indicate there are problems and difficulties in the very field that we are having the problems in the South, that there is segregation... whether they admit it, it's practiced segregation and steps are going to have to be taken in those areas."

President Tubman Outlines Conditions For Immigrants

MONROVIA, Liberia (ANP) — Sources here have pointed out that it has been the policy of the Tubman administration to encourage immigrants to come to Liberia. Early in the administration a group of immigrants from the West Indies came to Liberia and in accordance with the Immigration Policy, they were given 90-days free boarding and lodging and other accommodations during their period of adjustment.

These 300 American Negroes who are seeking entry and settlement into Liberia have already approached the government for the possibility of a 50,000 acre land grant. In this connection, President Tubman pointed out that the immigrants could acquire land in three ways: As immigrants, which would entitle a family to 25 acres of farm land and one town lot, as missionaries who may obtain land for charitable purposes or by leasing land from the government to operate businesses which would be subject to income tax and such other incumbrances.

President Tubman, speaking at his weekly press conference, told reporters that his government welcomes the idea of immigration; indeed, he said, the founding fathers felt so strongly about the need of immigration that they provided in the Constitution that the legislature cannot prohibit or inhibit the flow of immigrants into Liberia.

However, Tubman made it clear that "fanatics" persons with "police records" and others with strange ideologies or ideas can hardly be considered welcome in the country.
