### Man Ends Up Loser In Odd "Love Triangle"

TAMPA (ANP) — Sylvester Conage, 28, made an unusual decision last week. It not only cost him a burnt mattress and bed room, but almost his life. Conage claimed his "wife" had

agreed to take him back but his girl friend refused to give him up and set fire to the house. The girl friend, Miss Bertha Jean Wright, 20, wanted to remain No. 1 and when she couldn't promptly look the law into her own hands, police said. At the county jail where she was held under \$1000 bond on an arson charge, Miss Wright explained a bizarre arrangement Conage had made at their home.

"He wanted to bring a woman named Pearl Mae whom he has a child by to live in our house," the distraught woman said. "He wanted to put me in the back room while they slept up front." Miss Wright maintained that Conage was not married to Pearl Mae or to her, but the idea of two common-law wives living in the same house was just too much for her to take. She said he began beating her when she refused to accept the proposal, and then and only then, did she decide to burn the house. Taking a can of kerosene, Miss Wright sprinkled the combustible liquid on both beds, and throughout the house. She then lit a match and threw it on one of the beds. Conage, none the worst for wear

## "Forgotten Husband" Threatens To Break Up "Mixed" Marriage

SALISBURY, Southern Rhodesia (ANP) — An incredible marital tangle has emerged from the marriage in Blantyre, Nyasaland, of white Federal Broadcasting Engineer Stuart Cook, to the well-known black recording artist Dixie Kwanka.

An African living in South Africa is now claiming that Dixie really is his wife and that they were married seven years ago in Krugersdorp before a native commissioner in a civil marriage. The second man or rather, the first, as he claims to be—is Atwell Kwanka. He claims that he had two children by Dixie. One of them died and he wants to know where Dixie has taken the other. He has also stated "I want Dixie back and I mean to get her. I will take all action in my power to have the Blantyre marriage annulled."

### Students Who Boycotted High School Punished

SAVANNAH (ANP)—The Chatham County Board of Education has announced that students who boycotted Sol C. Johnson High School last March have been placed on probation for one year.

The punishment, affecting about 1,400 students, also calls for two additional days of classes in June to make up for time lost. The boycott resulted from the ouster of Harvard-educated principal Ailflore Cheatham, who the students charged was released because his views were "too liberal" for the school board. Another 1,000 students at two other Negro schools who joined the boycott in sympathy with the Johnson students were also placed on probation. The NAACP alleged the young

educator was dismissed because he was "too progressive."

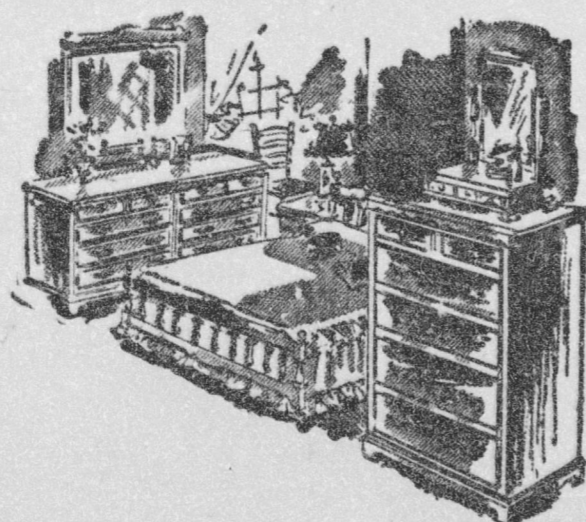
