Dope Addict Takes "Boost" On Way To Rehabilitation, Nabbed

PHILADELPHIA (ANP) - A New York musician, described as a heavy dope user, paused here on the way to the Federal Penitentiary and Rehabilitation Center at Lexington, Ky., to take a "booster shot" and was surprised and nabbed by police.
According to policemen making the arrest, Leroy Lombard, 33, of Long Island was to have voluntarily committed himself at the center in an attempt to cure the dope habit.

However, the policemen said he alighted from a bus from New York bound for Dallas, Tex., acting strangely and went into a washroom. Suspicious, the officers followed him to the washroom.
After questioning, they took him to headquarters for further investigation. They searched him and found his arms full of holes. He carried a set of "works" used in

taking heroin, they said.
Lombard, they added admitted using some four bags of heroin daily for the past eight months at a cost of \$10 a bag.
In court, his initial good intentions did not prevent Magistrate Henry J. Ellick from ordering him placed under \$500 bond for court. The judge ruled the defendant had violated a Philadelphia law by passing through the city with dope.

Study Of Anti-TB Vaccines Set

Plans for an unprecedented large scale human evaluation study of two anti-tuberculosis vaccines to be conducted in Haiti have been announced by Dr. H. Mac Vandiviere of Chapel Hill, co-director of the Haitian-American Tuberculosis Institute (HATI).
For the first time, Dr. Vandiviere pointed out, two well-standardized anti-tuberculosis vaccines are available for use in a medically virgin territory which has an adequate study population. "This opportunity is unique in the history of mankind," he said.

Matron Gets Life Term In Slaying Of Roomer

DETROIT (ANP) - Francis Moss, 27, convicted of second degree murder by a jury before Recorder's Judge John P. Scallen was sentenced to life in the House of Correction last week.
Mrs. Moss was charged with last May 31 fatal shotgun slaying of a roomer, Arthur Basons, 38, of the address during an altercation over three bags of potato chips and a bottle of wine.
Mrs. Moss said she gave Basons \$3 to purchase the potato

chips and wine at a neighborhood store. She said he didn't return until the following day at which time he had failed to purchase the chips and wine and refused to return her money.
Mrs. Moss said Basons became abusive and profane and she got the gun for protection. She said when Basons approached her and grabbed for the gun it discharged killing Basons.

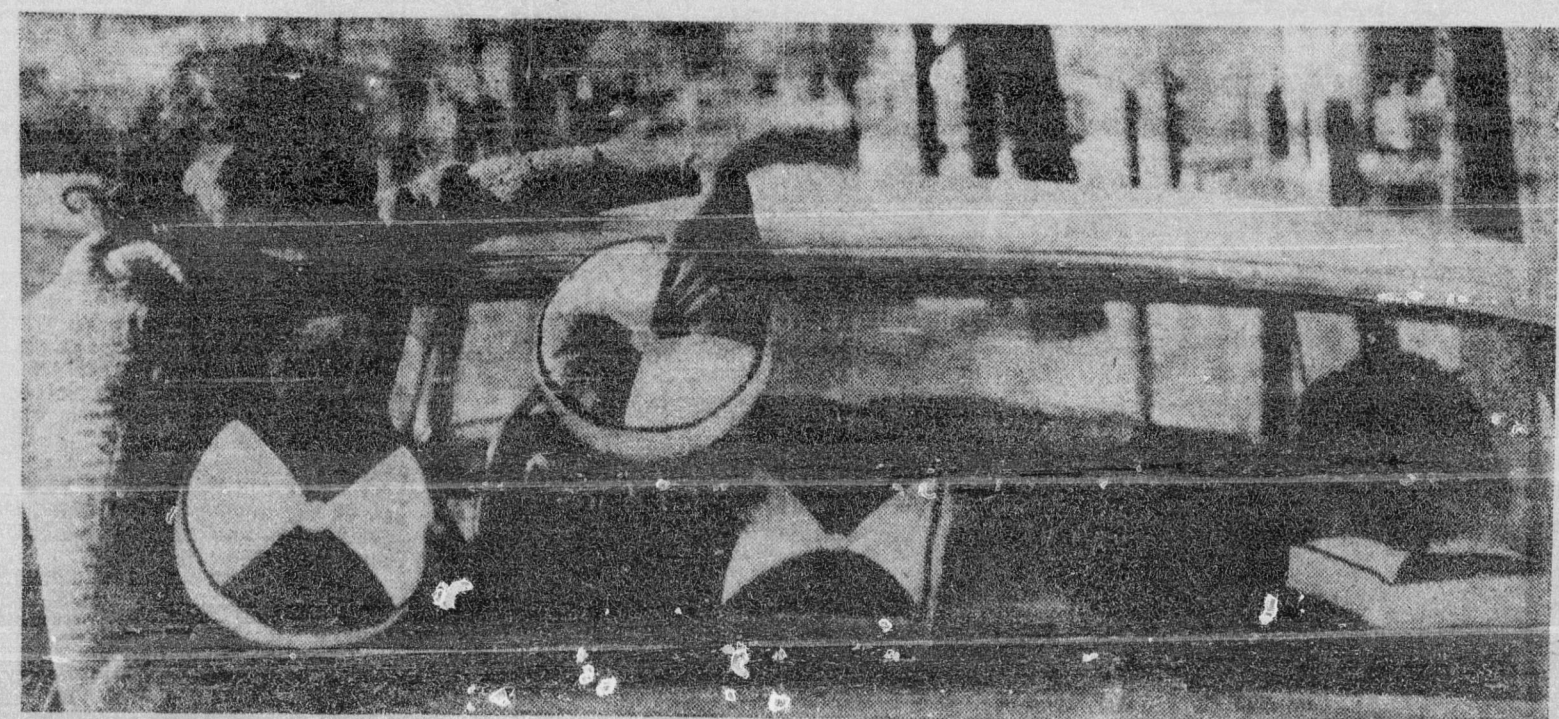
