A TRIBUTE TO DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING

One student, portraying Rev. Robert Galtz, a Montgomery minister whose house was bombed, stated "I am planting a tree in this bomb crater to remind us that in the midst of death there is life also."

In such an appropriate time for a program of this nature, the class conveyed many good points for everyone as the fight for freedom still persists. The skits also encompassed Rev. King's life as he worked for his fellow men and worked for his education in his home town of Montgomery, Alabama.
