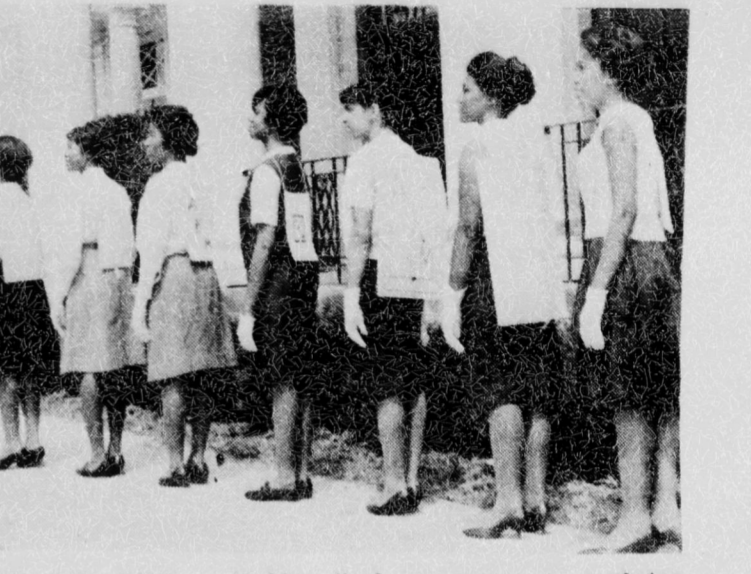

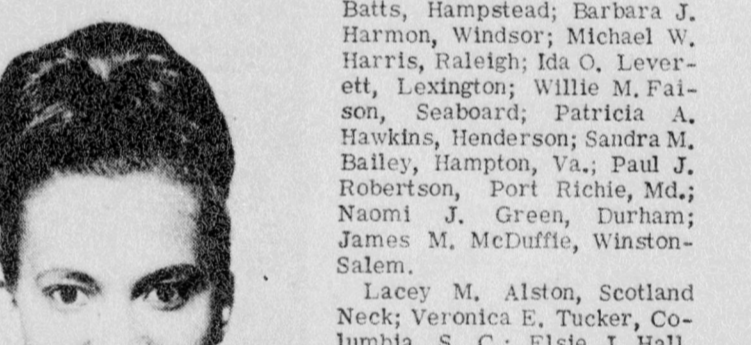

Fifty-One Graduate With Honor At N.C. College

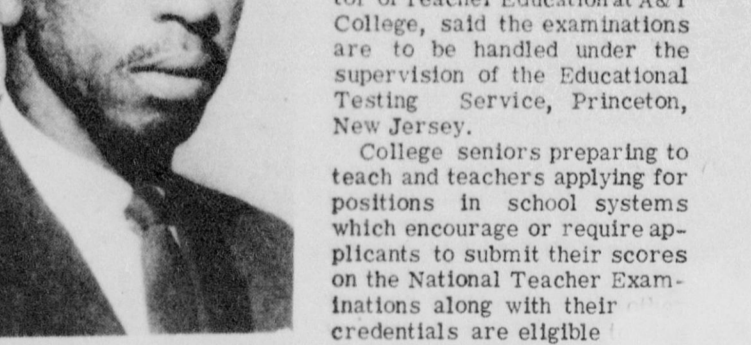
