Congress OK's Demonstration Cities' Plan To Change Way In Blighted Areas

WASHINGTON (NPD) - A new "Demonstration Cities" bill passed by Congress promised to change the way of life in blighted areas, in addition to knock-

ing slum buildings. The \$1.2 billion bill awaits the President's signature. As it bears his imprimatur, he is sure to sign the bill, which was pass-

ed by the House, 142 to 126. In the program, the federal government would pay 80 per cent of the cost of rebuilding whole neighborhoods, as well as providing social programs such as garbage collection, police service, parks, streets, sewer and water facilities, mass transit, schools, and health and welfare services.

Purpose of the new program is to counter two previous complaints about urban renewal. It merely changes the physical condition of a neighborhood, leaving its way of life as de-organized as ever.

It "removes" Negroes living in the area and replaces their dwellings with apartments too expensive for the former residents to afford. Thus, the problem of overcrowded housing in Negro areas is aggravated.

The new legislation counters these complaints by requiring that most of the housing be for the poor.

As many as 60 cities will be the locations of "Demonstration Cities" rehabilitation projects during the next two years. Some \$924 million would be available for rehabilitation work.

The bill also provides \$75 million for co-ordinated development of entire metropolitan areas.
