ties, and an instrumental repair room. The choir room, equipped with fixed opera chairs and a permanent stage, is designed for recitals, meetings, and other programs. One classroom is equipped with ten electronic Wurlitzer pianos.

The architect's view of the future campus shows high rise buildings and an immense outlay of capital improvements that will give the college the needed facilities that will enable it to give its students the type of training they will need to compete for existence in tomorrow's world.

Planners for this expense have and are now acquiring the land that lies directly in front of the campus, beginning at the stadium and running down to Cross Creek. This means that there will be vast expanse of property acquired and proper acreage will be available to continue the capital improvements.

\$21,600 Grant

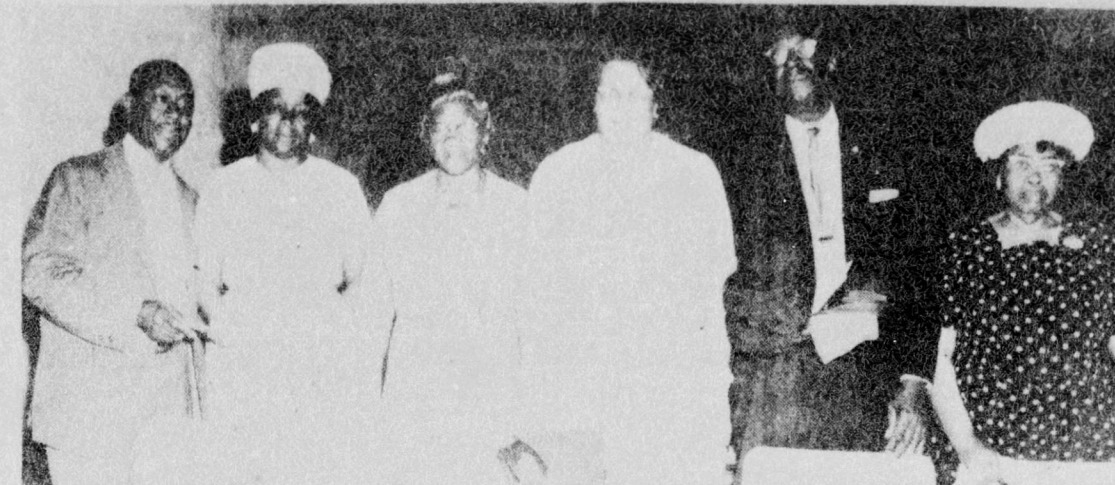
GRAMBLING, La. (SPECIAL) - Grambling College has been awarded \$21,600 by the Department of Health, Education and Welfare, Washington, D. C., for fellowship and traineeship grants to assist in the preparation of professional personnel in the education of handicapped children.

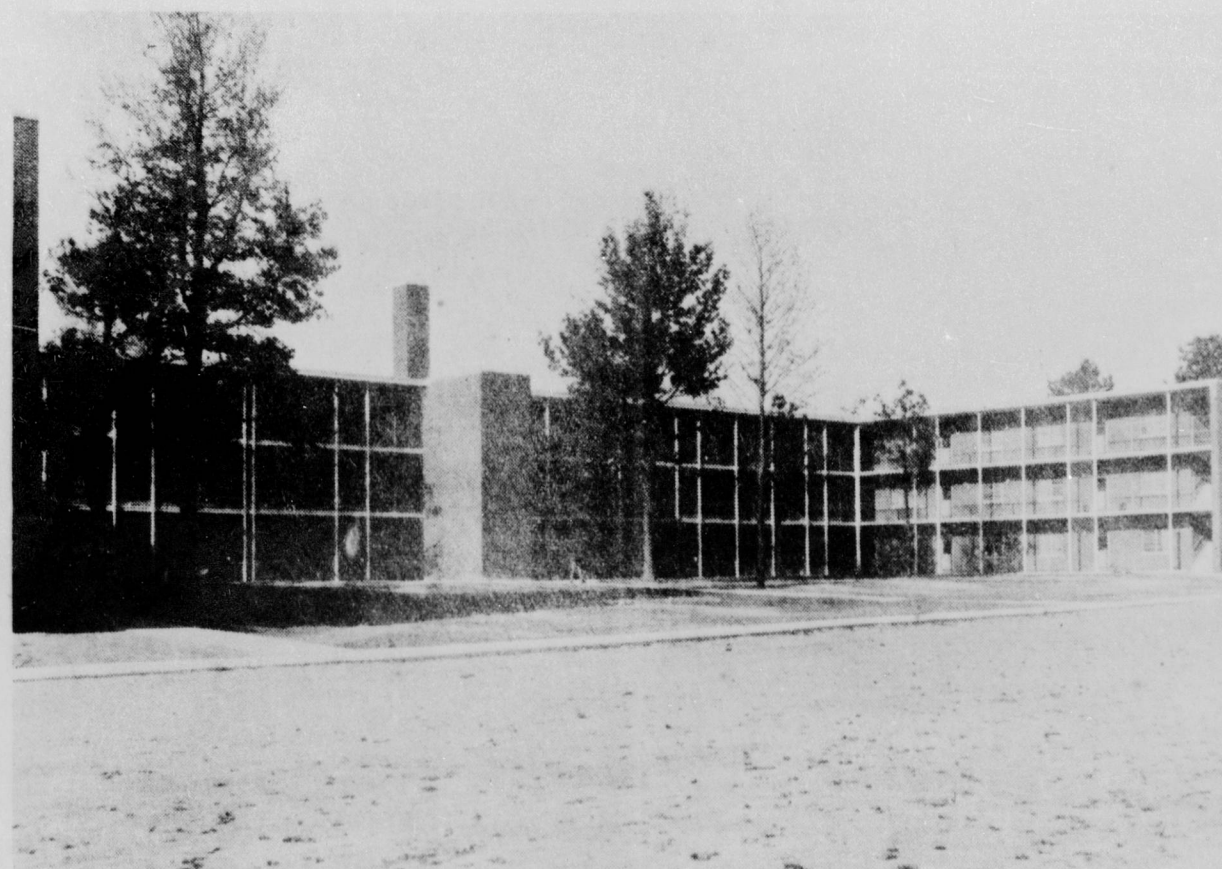
