

### Alexander Will Be Interviewed

WASHINGTON - Clifford L. Alexander, Jr., Chairman of the U. S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission will be interviewed by nationally known radio personality Del Shields on the first of a series of taped weekly radio programs dealing with job discrimination.

Greg Morris of "Mission Impossible" TV fame will give a special message on "What you should know about Equal Job Opportunity."

The program will be aired by local radio stations.

Shields is executive secretary of the National Association of Television and Radio Announcers (NATRA) which is promoting the series along with the owners of 200 radio stations throughout the country where its members are employed.

The Commission is the Federal agency established by Congress to administer Title VII of the Civil Rights Act that prohibits job discrimination based on race, color, religion, sex or national origin. EEOC Chairman Alexander will be interviewed by Shields and explain the functioning and operation of the Commission. Shields is widely known for his nationally broadcast radio show, "Night Call," that originates in New York City.

On succeeding programs, each a half hour in length, Shields will interview key members of the Commission's staff who will describe and explain how the Commission works against minorities and women by employers, unions and employment agencies.

Well known personalities of the entertainment world will participate in this new and different radio show which tells the story about Title VII and What You Should Know About Equal Job Opportunity.

### Arts School To Present Irene Dailey

WINSTON-SALEM - Bertolt Brecht's play, "Mother Courage," will open this week at the North Carolina School of the Arts with Broadway actress Irene Dailey in the title role.

Preview performances will be given without charge on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday, Feb. 25, 26 and 27. Opening night will be Friday, Feb. 28. Other performances will be March 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9. The play will be presented in the drama theater at the School of the Arts. All performances will be at 8:15 p.m., except on Sundays when the play will begin at 7 p.m.

Brecht's epic masterpiece takes place in Germany, Poland and Bavaria from 1624 to 1636, toward the end of the 30-Years-War. Mother Courage is an itinerant trader who follows the Swedish and Imperial armies with her covered wagon.

The play is a drama, yet much comedy is included as well as music and songs. The score is by Paul Dessau. A seven-piece orchestra of music students from the School of the Arts will play.

"Mother Courage" was written in 1938 during Brecht's 15-year period of exile from Germany. It was first produced in 1941 in Zurich, Switzerland. Ann Bancroft appeared in the Broadway production in 1963.

### Jackson State Listed in Top Ten Colleges

JACKSON, Miss. - The current edition of the Plans for Progress Directory of predominantly Negro colleges lists Jackson State College in the top ten in student enrollment among the 35 four-year predominantly Negro colleges and universities in the United States of America. Plans for Progress is a volunteer organization of more than 400 of America's largest corporations. Its purpose is to assure affirmative action in providing equal job opportunities for all Americans.

The colleges and universities listed with larger enrollments than Jackson State College were North Carolina A&T, 3,847; Florida A&M, 3,925; Prairie View A&M, 3,974; Morgan State College, 4,000; Grambling College, 4,154; Texas Southern University, 4,487; Tennessee State A&I University, 4,536; Southern University, 7,376; and Howard University, 9,439.

### VSC Receives Media Grant

PETERSBURG - Virginia State College was one of only 14 institutions in the nation to receive an educational media grant recently under the U. S. Office of Education.

The grant, which was won on a competitive basis for advanced study in educational media during the 1968-70 academic years, is designed for educational media coordinators, supervisors of professional laboratory experiences, education instructors and educational librarians in the South and bordering states.
