THE AUDIENCE

No speaker can go wrong by finding out all he can about the audience to whom he will speak. While all audiences have much in common, they still have their own individual characteristics.

To know your audience is to speak more effectively to them. By doing this, there are several factors which should be considered:

1. What is the interest of the listemers?

2. What is the background of your audience?

3. What is the occasion? 4. What is the size of the audience?

The larger the audience requires the speaker to use a more formal approach. Smaller groups demand greater intimacy and friendliness. If you know the size of the audience in advance, you will discover that it will be much easier to speak to

In delivering your subjectmatter, use illustrations, stories, figures, charts, and other adds. Explain what you mean by giving an example. Retell real incidents. Often one strong illustration, vividly told becomes effective.
