Colonial Declares Dividends

ATLANTA, Ga. - Directors of Colonial Stores Incorporated, 420-store Southeast and Midwest supermarket chain, Wednesday declared a quarterly dividend of 35 cents a share on common stock.

The regular quarterly cash dividend of 50 cents per share was declared on outstanding 4 percent preferred stock.

Both dividends are payable June 1, 1969 to stockholders of record on May 15, 1969.

Oliver Elected Chairman Of Bd. Of Directors

ATLANTA, Ga. - Lucien E. Oliver was elected Chairman of the Board of Directors of Colonial Stores Incorporated, 420-store Southeast and Midwest supermarket chain, recently after Russell B. Stearns announced his retirement from that office which he has held for many years.

The action came at the regular quarterly meeting here of the Colonial Board.

Mr. Oliver, who retired in January as Vice President in charge of the Southern Territory of Sears, Roebuck & Co., has been a member of the Colonial Board of Directors since 1951. He continues as a Director and member of the Executive Committee of Sears.

Mr. Stearns organized the present Colonial Company in 1940. He has actively participated in its development and growth from annual sales of \$47,000,000 to its present position as one of the nation's leading chains with annual sales of over \$562,000,000. At the request of the Board, he has agreed to continue as a Director and Chairman of the Executive Committee.

Ernest F. Boyce continues as President and Chief Executive Officer, and A. J. Long of Cincinnati, remains Vice Chairman of the Board of Directors.

Mr. Stearns is President and Director of National Food Products Corporation which owns approximately 33 percent of Colonial's common stock. He also is a Director of the Preston Moss Fund, Inc., and the Northeast Electronics Corporation, and formerly was on the Boards of Sears, Roebuck, the General Telephone and Electronics Corporation and the Copper Range Company.

Mr. Stearns makes his home in Dedham, Mass., where he has long been active in civic and philanthropic endeavors.

In addition to serving on the Boards of Colonial and Sears, Mr. Oliver also is a Director of the Allstate Insurance Company, the L&N Railroad, and the First National Bank of Atlanta. As Vice President in charge of Sears Southern Territory, Mr. Oliver had responsibility for operations in 13 states, including 132 retail stores, three catalogue order plants and approximately 400 catalogue sales offices. He is a graduate of the University of Idaho and became associated with Sears in 1933.

Colonial Stores has operations in the following states: Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Maryland, North Carolina, Ohio, South Carolina, and Virginia.
