Dr. Thomas Miller Jenkins, Albany State President, announced Sampson's selection as this year's commencement keynote following a meeting of the finals committee which met to complete plans for the three-day's of commencement activities.

Sampson became dean of the NCC Law School in 1965. He has been a member of the NCC law faculty since 1950. A graduate of Morehouse College, Sampson earned the M.A. degree at Albany University and the LL.D. and LL.M. degrees at Boston University. A veteran of World War II where he served overseas in the Pacific, he has also studied at Case Institute of Technology, New York University, and the University of California.

Sampson, who is a coopera-

tion lawyer of the NAACP Legal Redress Committee, is also co-chairman of the CLEO Summer Institute, a consortium sponsored by the Duke University - North Carolina College Schools of Law.

A member of the North Carolina State Bar, the Southeastern Lawyers Association, and the National Bar Association, Sampson, a member of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, is married to the former Claretta Scott.

A few weeks ago, he was decorated with the Bronze Star Medal at Charleston Air Force Base, Charleston, S. C. for meritorious service while engaged in military operations against Viet Cong forces. He was cited for his performance as a supply inventory supervisor with the 617th Military Airlift Support Squadron in Vietnam.
