Miss Laura Leola Edwards, the author of "Heaven-Bound" and a retired school teacher, passed at Rex Hospital last Friday, August 18th. She was funeralized at the St. Paul AME Church Sunday and burial was in Mt. Hope Cemetery.

Miss Edwards, a native of Raleigh, received her early training at the Washington School. She later attended Shaw University, Hampton Institute and completed her training at East Hampton, Massachusetts. She taught at the Holly Springs School, Holly Springs, and later at the State School for the Deaf, Dumb and Blind for 16 years. She was the social worker for Traveiers' Aid at the Union Station for a number of years. Later she became director of the local setup of the National Youth Administration. 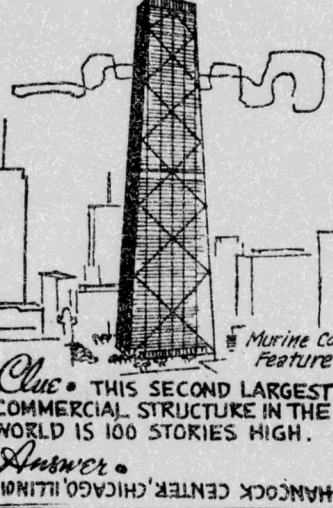
