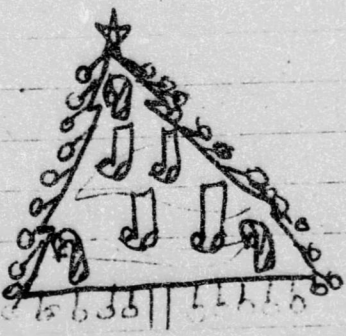


Dear Santa...
