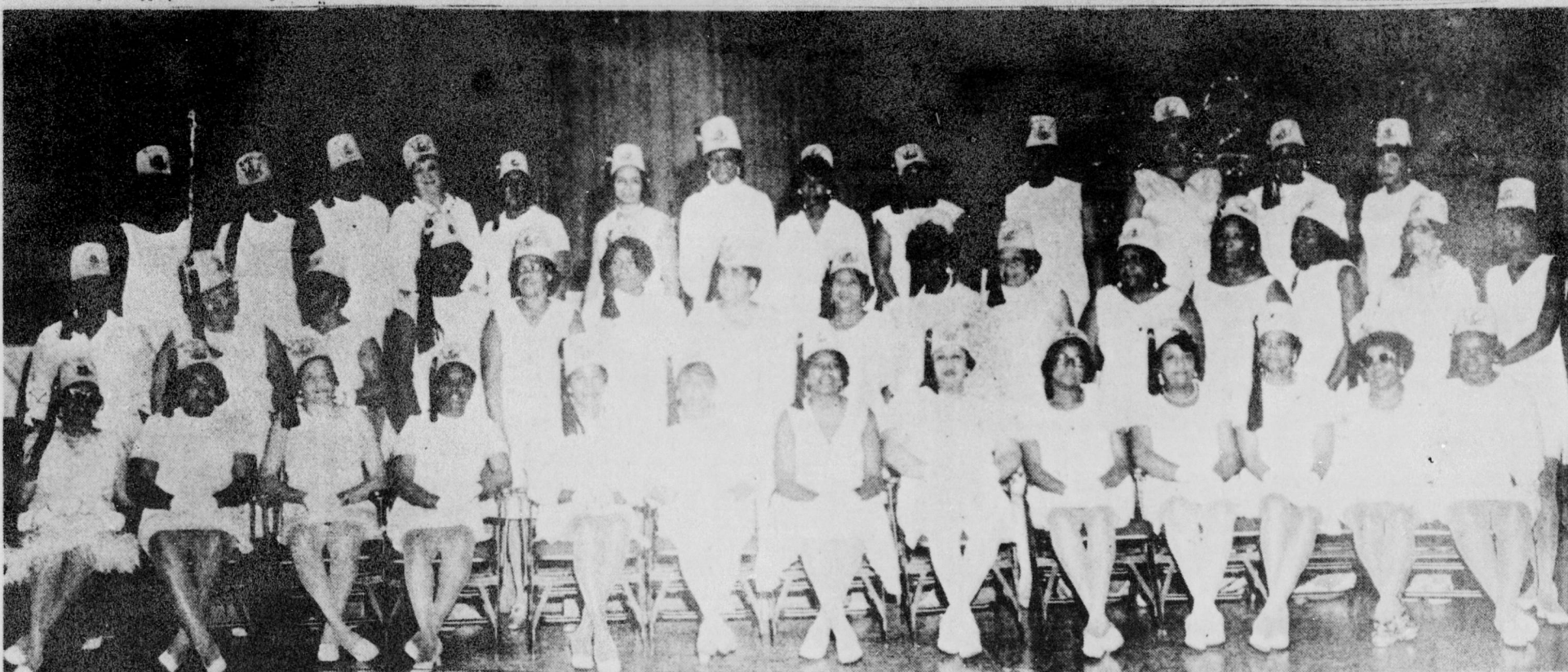
PHILADELPHIA HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS VISIT ST. AUG.

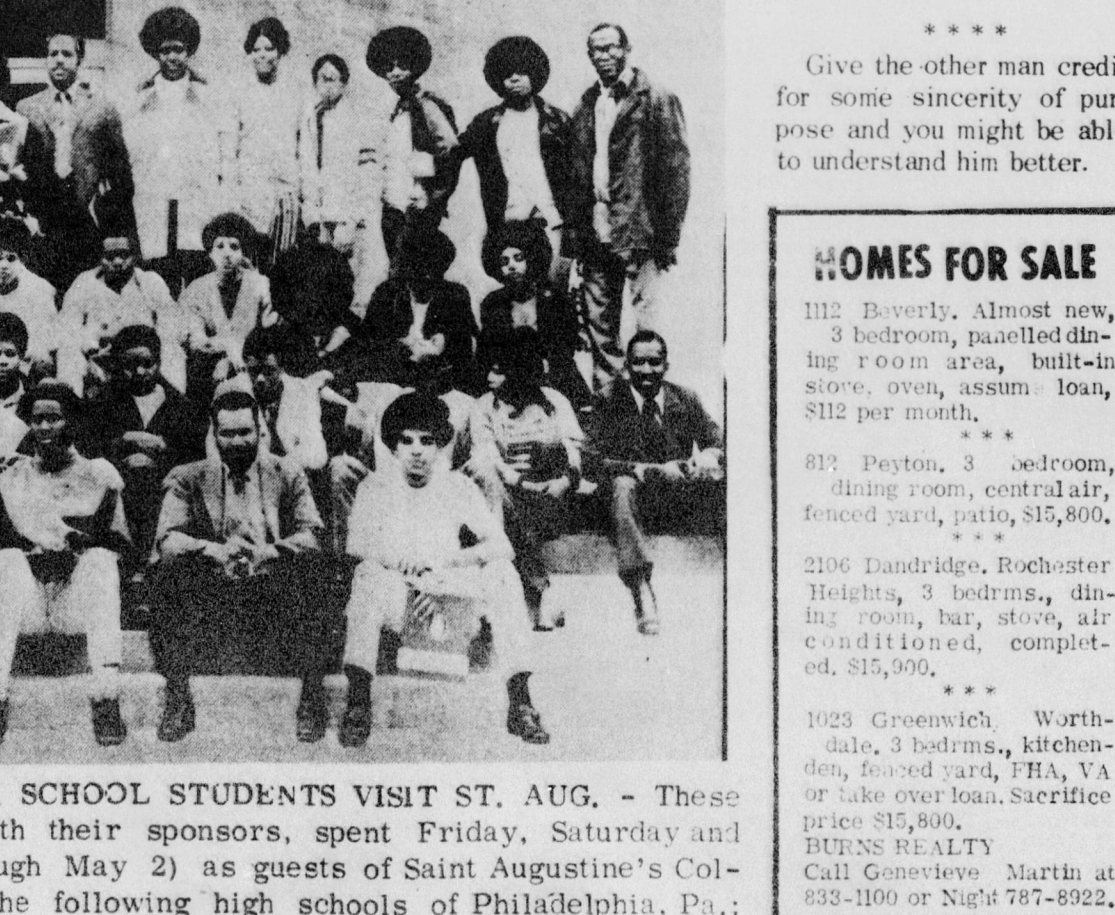
