Commission Finds Criticism, Distrust, But Sees Hope Signs

WASHINGTON—A blue-ribbon panel formed early this year to refocus national attention on the country's urban crisis issued its report last week. It found that while most of the changes in inner-city life since 1968 have been for the worse, plunging many people into cynicism, apathy, and despair, in other people there is a new tough pride, self-confidence, and determination to take the lead in improving their own lives without waiting for government to act.

The commission applauded this emerging sense of self-reliance but added that:

"We refuse to surrender our own conviction that government especially can be reformed so that it becomes what it should be: both servant and leader of the people—and not just a referee among society's conflicting claims."

SCLC's Williams Is Traveling In Nigeria

LAGOS, NIGERIA—Hosea Williams, Executive of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference, representing SCLC on a World-wide Brotherhood Tour, recently left Ghana and arrived in Lagos, Nigeria for a lengthy, closed meeting with the nation's Head of State—Major General Yakubu Gowon.

The meeting served as a platform for developing a reciprocal bridge for communication between Africans and Black Americans. Williams expressed to General Gowon, "Not only can Black Americans help Africans reach their potential, but Black Americans need help from their African brothers in fully realizing equality in America. The Black man's problems are not only national, they are international."

"We must, therefore, join hands across the seas to eliminate racism and poverty. With your help, Mr. President, there are five areas SCLC can get to work in immediately; namely, investments by American Blacks into the development of African nations; organizing Black American students to make their talents available to African countries needing them for national development; the development of a People-to-People Program beyond the boundaries of government treaties and diplomatic policies; organizing Blacks to spend their vacations in Africa to learn something about their homeland; and, marketing African arts and crafts."

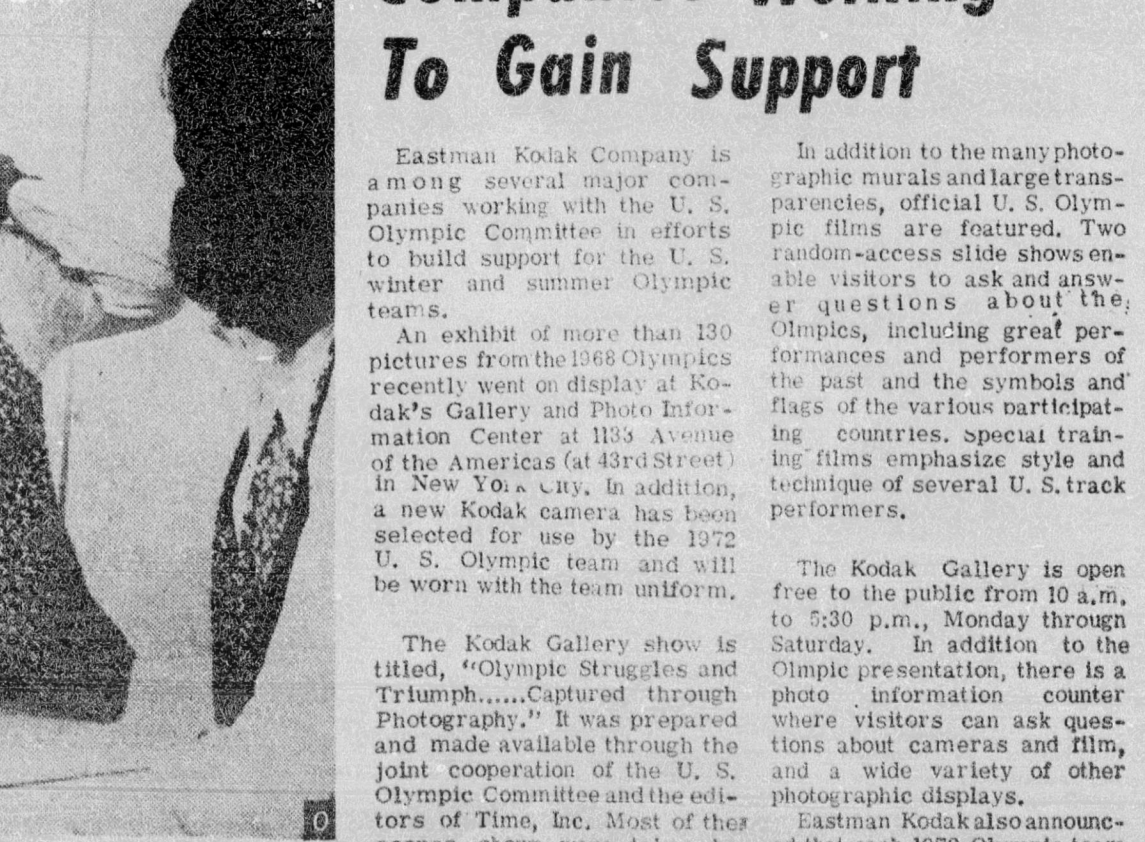

West Chester State Bombs Delaware

WEST CHESTER, Pa. — West Chester State rolled over Delaware State College here last Saturday before 7,800 with a 51-0 score.

The Ram's won the toss and did not waste any time scoring. They returned the opening kick off 19-yards and 8 plays later scored. The scoring drive was set-up with a 29-yard running play by Alray Johnson. Bob Wolfrum scored on the 2-yard line. Barry Stevenson, came on to kick the extra point, as he did five more time in this game.

Later in the quarter, Delaware's Robert Screen, a sophomore halfback from Washington, D. C. fumbled the football on the Delaware 10-yard line, and four plays later Wolfrum again scored from the two-yard line. Stevenson kicked the extra point.

The scoring in the second quarter was started by a 38-yard field goal by Stevenson. Later in that quarter, Randy Wynings scored from 17-yards out. Stevenson again kicked the extra point. The score was set-up by a 37-yard pass reception by Pete Young.

The only highlights for Delaware in the first half was a pass interception by Dana Billingslea, a junior defensive half-back from Washington, D. C. This play closed the first half. At the end of the first half, the score was 24-0 West Chester State.

The third quarter ran much the same way. The Ram's scored three touchdowns. The first touchdown came on a 8-yard running play by Alray Johnson. The second touchdown came on a 15-yard running play by Phil Hossler. He also scored the third touchdown on a 25-yard run. The extra point was missed by Stevenson.

The final touchdown was scored in the fourth quarter on a 16-yard pass reception by Dale Watkins. The score was set up by a 15-yard penalty against the Hornets. And coming in to kick his sixth extra point was Stevenson.
