Q — My son draws a VA pension based on his father's death. If he works during the summer, when not attending college, will his earnings affect his pension?

A — No. Under current pension law, earned income is not countable in determing pension entitlement for dependents.

Q - May a veteran pay off a GI loan before the date final payment is due?

A - Yes, A VA guaranteed loan may be partially or fully paid at any time without penalty.
