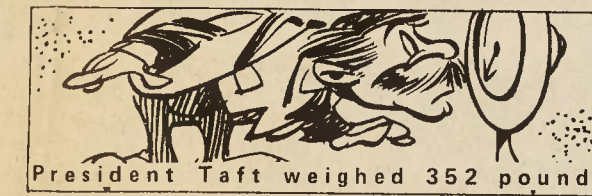

Vet's Corner

Editor's Note: Following are representative questions answered daily by VA counselors. Full information is available at any VA office.
Q—Is there a difference in the rate of Veterans Administration disability compensation paid for wartime and peacetime service?
A—No. The payment is the same for wartime and peacetime service.
Q—My father died in service. I am 18 years old and planning to start college in the fall. Since my mother has remarried, to I lose my Veterans Administration educational entitlement?
A—No. The remarriage of a spouse does not affect the child's educational benefit.
Q—What is the maximum amount on a Veterans Administration guaranteed home loan?
A—There is no maximum loan amount established by VA. However, the maximum amount of the guarantee cannot exceed 60 percent of the loan value of the home, up to a maximum of \$27,500.
