You don't have to sail the seven seas to discover buried treasure. Just open a can or jar of applesauce and create Apple Treasure Bread. Each bite reveals a wealth of chocolate chips, walnuts and golden raisins hidden in a moist cake-like bread.

Quick breads are jewels in any busy cook's recipe collection. As the name implies, they're made in minutes without the bother of kneading or lengthy rising times. Simply assemble ingredients and stir together in just one bowl.

Serve Apple Treasure Bread warm from the oven. Or, remove from the pan, cool slightly and wrap in aluminum foil. This "resting period" results in crumb-free slicing. The bread can also be frozen for later use. Applesauce keeps the texture moist and increases the storage time.

Apple Treasure Bread is special enough for Sunday brunch, yet easy enough to prepare for a middle-of-the-week treat.

APPLE TREASURE BREAD

- 2-1/3 cups buttermilk baking mix
- 1 cup old-fashioned rolled oats
- 3/4 cup sugar
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 cup semi-sweet chocolate pieces
- 1/2 cup golden seedless raisins
- 1/2 cup coarsely chopped walnuts
- 3 eggs, well beaten
- 1/3 cup vegetable oil
- 1 cup sweetened applesauce

Stir together first 4 ingredients. Add chocolate, raisins and nuts. Combine eggs, oil and applesauce; stir in. Mix for 1/2 minute. Spoon into greased 9x5x3" loaf pan. Bake at 350°F. 50-60 minutes. Cool bread in pan. Remove and wrap. Best served the day after baking for easier slicing.
