Dear Debbie: Please tell all your readers about the importance of getting a second opinion whenever a doctor mentions surgery. My husband had terrible cramps through his lower abdomen and a fever. The pains were so bad that he could barely stand. His doctor and a surgeon both told him his appendix had to come out, which was especially disheartening since we were supposed to leave for Europe the next weekend. We cancelled all our plans, but before my husband went in for surgery we happened to be talking to a physician friend who said, flatly, that the problem was not the appendix. It turned out my husband had a bout with diverticulitis, which is an intestinal problem. Given some antibiotics, he was feeling himself again within two days, and we were able to go to Europe. Two other doctors were scrubbed and ready to cut my husband up. I thank God we found out in time what the real problem was. But I wonder: How many people receive the wrong diagnosis and unnecessary surgery?

Dear Physician Phobic: I don't know how many people have had surgery when they didn't need it, but I know it happens. Doctors are not infallible, and most will readily admit it. They welcome the opinion of another doctor, and patients should feel free to get a second opinion whenever an important diagnosis is being made.

Dear Debbie: Our son has just turned 14 years old, and I'm afraid we are losing

all control over him. Whenever I tell him to do something, he has a mind of his own about what he wants to do and how to do it. He is not doing well in school, and we have asked that he come right home to do his homework before going out with his friends, but he constantly comes home late. He failed two of his classes last year and has had to go to summer school. I know it's no fun for him, but he has to do it. Besides that, he has a job because we want him to learn responsibility. We have grounded him when he comes home late, and he totally disregards our orders. Debbie, what can parents do when their kids start going bad? Is there anyway to stop it?

Dear Concerned Parents: It seems that you want your son to act like a responsible adult, yet you are treating him like a small child. It is very difficult for parents to slowly let go of the reins on their children—but you must. You cannot control your son's every move. The tighter your restrictions on him, the more he is likely to rebel. Let him choose his friends. You've said nothing that indicates what kind of bad influence they have on him. All kids come home late now and then. Set boundaries for your son, but let him determine on his own how he works within those boundaries. Learn to guide your son in the right direction with encouragement—rather than criticism. You also might want to consider getting him a tutor for those classes in which he is weak.
