Instead, they hired a retired male to take the other grade, who expressed pure joy at coming out of retirement to work with the

I talked with the counselor (I think she was) about some of our experiences here. Trying to identify, she told me the story of a little girl about two years go who was having some behavioral difficulties in kindergarten a few years previously. This child's mother was experiencing difficulties that the counselor couldn't address. She said she recognized that they had this kid for seven hours a day and that it hit her that the home needn't get in the way of school. She talked with the child and told her that she expected her to shine. She says that this kid gives her the OK sign everytime she sees her and consistently scores in the 99th percentile on the CAT achievement test they use.

While we were there lunchtime arrived. The children, for some reason (some of them) carried their lunch to the cafeteria. Perhaps overcrowding, perhaps some malfunction. Whatever—they all did so in an orderly fashion. What really shocked me is that they did so without the accompaniment or policing of the teachers. Yes, they were normal kids, no, they were not robots, yes, some swaggered and others walked straight—it just didnt matter at this school what the differences were in perosnality, dress, looks or economic condition. How I long for my children to experience a school such as this, for with the exception of the newness of the facility, it was the school of my childhood. Incidentally, every child I saw was African-American.

This was a public school of all-black Lawnside, N.J., where the mayor is an African-American as well as the schooll board and superintendent. I saw no evidence of homelessness, drug addiction or alcoholism on the streets—no mumbling humans walking aimlessly from pillow to post. As I drove back to North Carolina and reviewed my experience in my mind, the thought that came to me was-Home is where they always let you in.
