## THE FIX-IT SHOP

**Exterior Painting Tips**  
On windows, paint the wood dividing the glass first. Then paint the frame, trim, sill and apron. Shutters and storm windows are easier to paint if removed from the house and laid flat on supports, like saw horses. Clean off dust and dirt before painting. Shrubbery might need to be covered with drop cloths. Windows are easier to paint and clean afterward if the glass is masked. One simple way to protect the glass is to cover it with pieces of wet newspaper. When you strip the newspaper from the glass after painting, the paint will come with it. Another method is to wipe a light layer of petroleum jelly such as vaseline around the edges of the glass with your finger. After the paint has dried, the jelly and paint can be cleaned away with any ordinary glass cleaning compound.  
Both masking tape and liquid masking are available at hardware and paint stores. Masking tape is applied around all the edges of the glass, bordering all wood areas to be painted. When the

## YOU AND YOUR HEALTH

Dear Dr. DeMarco: Can multiple sclerosis be effectively treated with high pressure oxygen?  
Answer: It appears, from recent research, that patients who have recently developed multiple sclerosis (MS) benefit from hyperbaric oxygen therapy (HBO), or what you call high pressure oxygen.  
HBO, scarce and expensive in this country, is known primarily for its use with deep-sea divers to prevent the bends. Presently, there are only about 150 HBO chambers used medically at this time here. The number probably will grow rapidly.  
During HBO treatment, patients are in an HBO chamber where their bodies are subjected to an 100 percent oxygen atmosphere at two to three times normal atmospheric pressure. Oxygen concentrations in their bloodstreams increase about 10-15 times normal and apparently help keep tissues alive that have been deprived of their normal blood supply.  
MS is called the crippler of young adults, since it is the most common central nervous system disorder among such people in the U.S., has no known cause, an unpredictable course, a wide variety of symptoms and no known cure.  
Some researchers say that HBO is the most effective treatment that can be given to "early MS." If given early, it can arrest MS in 70 percent of patients. The only known side effect from HBO is minor ear problems from the pressure.

## Auto Talk

**Keeping Cool**  
Summer and hot days are here again. Have you had your air conditioner checked over lately? For most car owners, using their car's air conditioning is taken for granted. An air conditioning tune-up, however, could save you some big bucks at a later date while giving you a trouble-free, cool driving season.  
While there are many causes for your air conditioner to work poorly or even fail, some common problems often occur. One item, the compressor belt, might be slipping from being too loose, or it may be worn out and need to be replaced. The controls used for opening and closing the vents and ducts sometimes go haywire and need to be replaced or adjusted. Sensors and many of the intricate working parts also can fail. Air conditioning specialists are trained to detect and fix these.  
It's easy to check the performance of the air conditioner in your car. The system needs to run for about five minutes with the windows closed. Next insert a thermometer into an opening where the cool air comes out. The thermometer should read somewhere between 35 to 45 degrees. If the temperature is not low enough, then the system may need to be recharged.  
Running your air conditioner when the refrigerant is low can cause damage to the compressor. Recharging your air conditioning unit the right way requires purging the system and replacing the refrigerant.  
The refrigerant used in air conditioning systems belongs to a class of chemicals called chlorofluorocarbons, commonly known as fluorocarbons. Lost refrigerant from automotive air conditioners is estimated to be responsible for between 15 and 20 percent of ozone destruction.  
Car Bob urges you to have your air conditioning unit recharged by a shop that has refrigerant recycling equipment in use.  
By having our air conditioner checked over and serviced in a responsible shop, you can do your part in keeping the atmosphere clean and have a cool car to drive.
