high pressure oxygen? Answer: It appears. from recent research, that patients who have recently developed multiple sclerosis (MS) benefit from hyperbaric oxygen therapy (HBO), or what you call high pressure oxygen.

HBO, scarce and expensive in this country, is known primarily for its use with deep-sea divers to prevent the bends. Presently, there are only about 150 HBO chambers used medically at this time here. The number probably will grow rapidly.

During HBO treatment, patients are in an HBO chamber where their bodies are subjected to an 100 percent oxygen atmosphere at two to three times normal atmospheric pressure. Oxygen concentrations in their bloodstreams increase about 10-15 times normal and apparently help keep tissues alive that have been deprived of their normal blood supply. MS is called the crip-






