

**COAST GUARD TRAINING FOR HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES**

The United States Coast Guard announced they will enlist high school graduates, who have not had previous military active service in any branch of the Armed Forces, in the new High School Graduate Training Program.

This program will enable a high school graduate to be accepted for resident school training and he will be given the rating of SR (X) to identify him in this program.

Applicants must have proof substantiating that he is a high school graduate, or proof of completion of an eighth grade education followed by graduation from a full four year course in technical vocational school.

Upon completion of basic training eighteen petty officer schools will be made available under this program and will include: Electronics Technician, Aviation Electronics Technician, Aviation Mechanic's Mate, Aviation Structural Mechanic, Fire Control Technician, Damage Controlman, Commissaryman, Radarman, Storekeeper, Radioman, Yeoman, Electrician's Mate, Engineman, Boilerman, Machinist's Mate, Sonarman, Hospital Corpsman, Gunner's Mate.

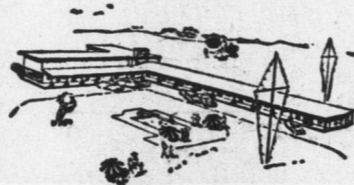
